Evan Day of Highlands Top Flier

Evan Day of North Highlands with co-pilots Norman Dittman of Rancho Cordova and William Keck of Sacramento was a \$500 winner for first place in the annual Hayward-Las Vegas Air Races held on May 15th.

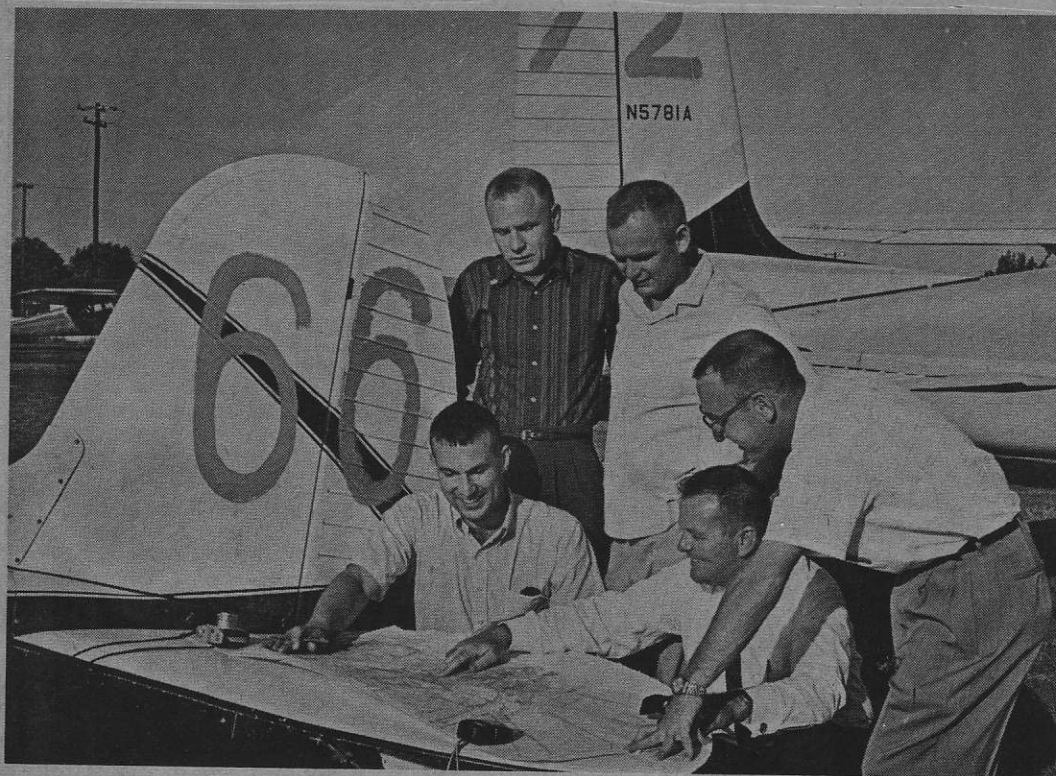
They flew a Cessna 172 and won by landing at Las Vegas within 10 seconds of their estimated time out of Hayward and to the exact gallon of their estimated fuel consumption.

These fliers were members of the Sacramento Chapter of the American Aero Club, which entered five single engine airplanes in the annual race. There were 74 entrants from California, Texas and Oregon and in the proficiency class of the race, AMAERO entrants took 1st, 4th and 5th places.

Fourth place winners of \$100 were chief pilot of the club, Russell Kilmer of Sacramento and his co-pilot Erwin Hayer, son of the owner of the Rio Linda airport, home field of the club.

Fifth place winners of \$50 were Ken Bonsall of Sacramento and his co-pilot Michael Trindade of Sacramento.

American Aero Club, a non-profit organization with a current membership of 85, flies out of both Rio Linda and Sacramento Municipal Airports.
