

2024 Hayward Air Rally Checkpoint Photos and Answers

Checkpoint 1 - Los Medanos College Football Field



Checkpoint 1

Football Field

Elevation 79'
Overfly Above 2500'
3500' recommended for Travis transition

Lat N 38° 00.29' Long W 121° 51.48'

At this location, immediately south of the divided highway (CA Hwy 4), there is a large school campus with prominent white buildings. The markings on the football field are:

- A. Fresh and clearly visible
- B. Faded and hard to read
- C. Missing altogether



The Google Earth image suggests answer B. Another field 1 mile further west suggests answer C.

Checkpoint 2 - Winters High School Football Field



Checkpoint 2

Winters

Elevation 140' Overfly Above 2500' Lat N 38° 31.49' Long W 121° 58.44'

(GPS coords weren't provided)

The town of Winters is charted about 8nm north of Nut Tree (VCB). At the high school in the middle of town, the football field:

D. Has a blue track

E. Appears unmarked

F. Is marked prominently with the school mascot



The field looked different a couple months ago, and the pool was empty...

Checkpoint 3 - Franklin Field



Checkpoint 3 Franklin Field (F72)

Elevation 23' Lat N 38° 18.24' Overfly Above 2500' Long W 121° 25.75'

Just east of the approach end of Runway 18, on the other side of the taxiway, I

G. An open ended Quonset hut style structure (no walls at north and south faces)

H. An enclosed Quonset hut style structure (walls at north and south faces)

J. No large structures, just a big concrete pad.

Checkpoint 4 – Eagles Nest (CA20)




Checkpoint 4 Eagles Nest (CA20)

Elevation 220' Lat N 38° 26.04' Overfly Above 2500' Long W 121° 00.74'

This airport has:

- P. A runway marked 1-19, with an adjacent parallel taxiway
- R. A runway marked 1-19, and another runway marked 15-33
- S. A runway marked 1-19, and a long diagonal taxiway.

Checkpoint 5 – Don Pedro Reservoir (Optional Bonus)



Checkpoint 5 Optional Bonus

Don Pedro Reservoir

Elevation 900' Overfly Above 2500' Lat N 37° 42.60' Long W 120° 26.07'

(GPS coords weren't provided)


There is a dam and power station charted at the southwest end of the reservoir. North of the dam, along the western-most shore of the reservoir, is a campground/recreation area with a network of short curvy roads. These roads can be described as:

T. Darkest in the northern portion.

U. Darkest in the middle portion.

V. Darkest in the southern portion.

W. Evenly colored throughout the area.



It looks like they might be repaying from south to north. The older Google Earth image suggests answer V.

Checkpoint 6 – Fiorini Ranch (0CN1)

Fiorini Ranch (0CN1)

Elevation 140' Overfly Above 2500'


Lat N 37° 27.19' Long W 120° 45.91'

On the west side of the airstrip, roughly midfield, there is a large building with a row of (4) smaller reddish roofed buildings to the south. Between the large building and the row of buildings are:

X No other small buildings.

Y. A single small building.

Z. Several other small buildings.



The Google Earth image shows multiple buildings and suggests answer Z.
